



PEDIGREE PROFILE

Citronnade newest graded winner in highly accomplished family

On Sunday, the four-year-old Lemon Drop Kid filly Citronnade sprinted clear of her peers in the lane and scored her first graded stakes victory in the 1½-mile San Gorgonio Handicap (G2) over the turf at Santa Anita Park.

It was the bay Kentucky-bred's third victory from four starts since Racing Hall of Fame trainer Bobby Frankel switched her to the grass last fall. She also captured the Audrey Skirball-Kenis Stakes in November at Hollywood Park and the Graceful Darby Stakes in September at Belmont Park.

Her career mark now stands at five wins from eight starts with earnings of \$252,800.

CITRONNADE

An Adena Springs homebred, Citronnade is the fourth black-type winner out of the Lord At War (Arg) mare Primarily, a Canadian stakes winner as a juvenile.

Named 2000 Canadian Broodmare of the Year, Primarily is the dam of Primaly (by Alydeed) and Poetically (by Silver Deputy), who received Sovereign Awards in 1997 and 2000, respectively, as Canada's champion two-year-old filly.

Primarily also has produced Whiskey Wisdom (by Wild Again), a Grade 3 winner at Keeneland Race Course and a successful sire in Ontario.

The immediate family also includes 1983 Apple Blossom Handicap (G1) winner Miss Huntington, a half sister to Citronnade's grandam, Mostly, as well as Assault Handicap (G3) winner Must Be War—a son of Lord At War and, thereby, a three-quarter brother to Primarily.

Citronnade hails from the second crop of the Kingmambo stallion Lemon Drop Kid. The former handicap champion stands at Lane's End in Versailles, Kentucky with a 2007 stud fee of \$20,000. His 2006 stakes winners include Kentucky Oaks (G1) winner Lemons Forever and multiple Grade 3 winner Cosmonaut.

Champion Argentine miler and Santa Anita Handicap (G1) winner Lord At War is the broodmare sire of 27 stakes winners, including 2002 Kentucky Derby (G1) winner War Emblem and Suburban Handicap

Citronnade's 14th dam, *Myrtle (1834), was imported at age two to the United States where her daughter Magnolia, by *Glencoe, forged one of the great American families (#4-m).
