# In Summation puts it all together in Bing Crosby thriller

In Summation, a four-year-old colt by Put It Back, enjoyed the biggest victory of his career on July 29 when he rallied gamely and held off Greg's Gold by a nose to capture the \$300,000 Bing Crosby Handicap (G1) at Del Mar.

In Summation covered six furlongs in 1:11.06, the fastest time for the distance this summer over the track's new Polytrack surface.

The bay colt's successful transition to the synthetic surface follows six consecutive starts on grass. Prior to the Bing Crosby, he scored a one-length victory in the 5½-furlong Sneakbox Stakes at Monmouth Park.

During his three-year-old season, In Summation was the runner-up in the Hollywood Turf Express Handicap (G3) and Nearctic Stakes (Can-G2). At two, he was voted Florida's top juvenile after coming within a nose of completing an undefeated six-race campaign at Calder Race Course and a sweep of the 2005 Florida Stallion Stakes series.

The Bing Crosby was his seventh victory in 17 career starts, boosting his earnings to \$670,226. Bred by Arthur I. Appleton in Florida, In Summation was purchased by Mike Maniscalco for \$130,000 at the 2005 Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. March sale of selected two-year-olds in training.

In Summation is one of five winners out of the Dayjur mare Fiesta Baby, a multiple winner at age three. His half brother, Dakota Duke, by Stormy Atlantic, was a stakes winner at Stampede Park in Canada.

Dayjur broodmares have combined, so far, to yield ten graded or group stakes winners, including last weekend's Alfred G. Vanderbilt Stakes (G2) winner Diabolical, by Artax.

In Summation's granddam, Fiesta Gal, won the 1987 Mother Goose Stakes (G1) and Coaching Club American Oaks (G1). His fourth dam, Jambo, is a half sister to 1967 Kentucky Oaks winner Nancy Jr. The family also is the distinguished clan of French Group 1 winners Maximova (Fr), Macoumba, Septieme Ciel, and Nonoalco.

The extended family first reached American shores in the late 1920s,

when In Summation's eighth dam, 1927 Irish Oaks winner \*Cinq a Sept, was imported to Kentucky. She also is the matriarch of the immortal Secretariat.

In Summation hails from the first crop of the Honour and Glory stallion Put It Back, who stood the 2007 season at Bridlewood Farm in Ocala for \$5,000.

Put It Back won all five of his starts as a three-year-old, including the Riva Ridge Stakes (G2), before a shin injury forced his early retirement. His first crop of runners also includes multiple stakes winner Smokey Stover, another top contender in the sprint division.

In Summation is an eighth generation tail-male descendant of the great Man o' War, whose sire line, through In Reality, currently makes up a steady 4% to 5% of the American Thoroughbred population.
