# Dixie Union colt Fierce Wind joins Kentucky Derby trail

Tactical speed made the difference in the \$200,000 Sam F. Davis Stakes as Fierce Wind shook free from his opponents at the top of the stretch and held off a late charge from Big Truck to score a half-length victory in the race for three-year-olds on February 16 at Tampa Bay Downs.

The win was the third consecutive victory and first stakes triumph for the Dixie Union colt, who completed the 1 $\frac{1}{16}$ -mile contest in a swift 1:44.13.

### FIERCE WIND

Unplaced in sprints in his first two career starts, Fierce Wind showed marked improvement when stretched out to two turns. He broke his maiden with a front-running 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ -length romp going one mile and 70 yards on December 16 at Calder Race Course and followed up on January 21 at Gulfstream Park with a pacesetter win by 5 $\frac{1}{4}$  lengths in a 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ -mile allowance race.

Fierce Wind's career record stands at three wins in five starts and earnings of \$146,200. Bred in Kentucky by William S. Farish, Hilbert Thoroughbreds, and Menard Thoroughbreds, Fierce Wind was sold for \$90,000 at the 2006 Keeneland September yearling sale. In March 2007, he was listed as a reserve not attained after bringing a final bid of \$300,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Calder sale of selected two-year-olds in training.

He is one of five winners from as many starters out of the winning A.P. Indy mare Post Parade. Fierce Wind's older full brother, Rebel Yeller, captured the 2007 Woodlawn Stakes at one mile on the grass at Pimlico Race Course.

The 2008 Sam F. Davis marked the third consecutive year the race was won by a colt out of an A.P. Indy mare. Any Given Saturday, by Distorted Humor out of Weekend in Indy, won in 2007, and Bluegrass Cat, by Storm Cat out of She's a Winner, captured the 2006 edition.

Post Parade is a full sister to multiple Grade 3 winner Parade Queen, dam of 2006 Sorrento Stakes (G3) winner Untouched Talent. The family is anchored by Fierce Wind's fourth dam, \*Bitty Girl, who was England's champion two-year-old filly of 1973. The clan also includes Action This Day, an Eclipse Award winner as champion two-year-old male of 2003.

Fierce Wind hails from the fourth crop of the Dixieland Band stallion Dixie Union, a multiple Grade 1 winner who stands for \$50,000 at Farish's Lane's End in Versailles, Kentucky.

Dixie Union's current crop of three-year-olds also includes Grade 1 winner Dixie Chatter and Grade 3 winner Turf War. The latter's older full brother, Grasshopper, recently won the Mineshaft Handicap (G3) at Fair Grounds and was a gallant second to Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (G1) winner Street Sense in last year's Travers Stakes (G1).

Fierce Wind's Triple Crown aspirations are certainly bolstered by the sires of his first three dams, A.P. Indy, Roberto, and Nijinsky II, who all were classic winners and breed-shaping sires.
