Frozen Fire rekindles Irish Derby glory for sire line, stable

Reserved early while finishing widest, Frozen Fire managed to avoid all of the trouble inside him while sweeping to a determined two-length



victory in the \$2,368,500 Dubai Duty Free Irish Derby (Ire-G1) at the Curragh on June 29.

Sent offat odds of 16-to-1 in a field of eleven as part of trainer Aidan O'Brien's five-horse assemblage, the Montjeu (Ire) colt covered 1½ miles in 2:31.96 on turfrated as good to yielding.

The victory represents his con-

ditioner's sixth Irish Derby triumph, equaling the record set by his predecessor at Ballydoyle, the legendary Dr. Vincent O'Brien, who is not related.

Bred in Germany by Jurgen and Wolfgang Hoyer, Frozen Fire was sold as a yearling in Ireland for 250,000 euros at the 2006 Goffs February sale.

He is the second winner from as many starters out of the winning Woodman mare Flamingo Sea, a half sister to two European group winners, including 1999 Preis der Diana (German Oaks) (Ger-G2) winner Flamingo Road.

This is also the family of Grade 1 winners Personal Hope and My Trusty Cat as well as multiple graded winners Best Of Luck, Dixie Flag, and Betty Lobelia.

Frozen Fire hails from the fourth crop of the Sadler's Wells stallion Montjeu, Europe's champion three-year old colt of 1999, when he

captured both the French and Irish Derbies prior to his conquest of elders in the Prix de l'Arc De Triomphe Lucien Barriere (Fr-G1).

A leading sire in France in 2005, Montjeu stood for a 2008 fee of 125,000 euros at Ballydoyle's complementary facility, Coolmore Stud in County Tipperary, Ireland. He is joined there by his son, Hurricane Run, and fellow Sadler's Wells scions Galileo (Ire) and High Chaparral (Ire).

An Irish Guineas winner in the Vincent O'Brien stable later to become one of Europe's all-time great sires, the 27-year old Sadler's Wells was retired in May from stud duty due to declining fertility.

Remarkably, Sadler's Wells and his sons have sired ten of the last twenty Irish Derby winners (see accompanying chart). For good measure, the same lot has bred five of the last eight Epsom Derby (Eng-G1) winners.

Indeed, the Sadler's Wells male line, emboldened by its prepotent classic nature, is one of Europe's ongoing dynasties.
