## California Nectar savors the fruits of victory in Santa Ynez

Pablo and Michelle Suarez's homebred California Nectar led throughout and gamely held off favored Zazu to secure her first graded stakes victory by a neck in the \$150,000 Santa Ynez Stakes (G2) on January 15 at Santa Anita Park.

The three-year-old Stormy Atlantic filly covered seven furlongs in

1:21.34 on Santa Anita's new dirt track, which was rated as fast.

The improving bay filly entered off an impressive 1½-length score in the California Breeders' Champion Stakes on December 27, also run at seven furlongs at the Arcadia, California, track.

The Santa Ynez score sweetens California Nec-

tar's career mark to three wins and three seconds from seven lifetime starts and earnings of \$213,800.

Bred in the California, California Nectar is one of two winners from as many starters out of the multiple stakes-placed Carson City

mare Absolute Nectar. More recently, Absolute Nectar has produced a twoyear-old filly and a yearling colt, both by Atticus.

California Nectar represents the first graded stakes winner under her first three dams. Her third dam, From Sea to Sea, produced multiple stakes winner Sealaunch, by Relaunch.

California Nectar's fourth dam, Betty's Secret, produced Secreto, winner of the 1984 Ever Ready Epsom Derby (Eng-G1). This also is the family of Italian Group 1 winner Close Conflict and stakes winner and sire Newton's Law.

California Nectar hails from the ninth crop of the consistent Storm Cat stallion Stormy Atlantic and is one of her sire's 21 graded or group stakes winners.

2011 fee of \$30,000. His leading runners in 2010 included multiple Grade 2 winner Get Stormy, Grade 3 winner Stormy's Majesty, and English group stakes winner Rerouted.

So far, the cross of Stormy Atlantic with daughters of Carson City has generated three stakes winners from 23 foals of racing age, including 2006 Hollywood Futu-

rity (G1) winner Stormello.

It is interesting to note California Nectar's fifth dam, Betty Loraine, is a half sister to Racing Hall of Famer and influential sire Majestic Prince. The latter appears in the fourth generation of Stormy Atlantic's pedigree, thereby reinforcing our subject's tail-female line.
