

D' Funnybone's family has abundance of stamina influences

After stalking the early pace, D' Funnybone grabbed the lead midway on the turn and then drew off without challenge to score a commanding 4¾-length victory in the 120th running of the Futurity Stakes (G2) on September 19 at Belmont Park.

Winner of the Saratoga Special Stakes (G2) by 10½ lengths on August 20 in his previous start, the two-year old D'wildcat colt was sent off in the Futurity as the prohibitive 0.45-to-1 favorite in the field of eight. His time for seven furlongs was 1:22.40 on a track rated as fast.

Bred in Florida by Harold J. Plumley, D' Funnybone was purchased privately by Paul P. Pompa Jr. after a solid runner-up effort in the Frank

Gomez Memorial Stakes on July 11 at Calder Race Course.

With the Futurity victory, his record improved to three wins and a second from four lifetime starts and earnings of \$278,000.

The chestnut colt's next big contest is yet to be decided. Interestingly, over the past 25 years not a single winner of Belmont's prestigious

Futurity Stakes has gone on to capture the Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1).

Even though D' Funnybone hails from the sire line of a sprinter, he receives plenty of stamina influences from the bottom half of his pedigree.

He is one of three winners from as many starters out of the Woodman mare Elbow, a winner at age three of two races, including a Laurel Park allowance event at 1% miles

Elbow also is the dam of the Polish Numbers filly Dr. Kathy, a stakes winner on turf and graded stakes-placed at two.

Elbow produced a colt by Pomeroy this year. She currently is in foal to the Forest Wildcat stallion Wildcat Heir.

The most celebrated member of D' Funnybone's immediate family is his third dam, 1981 Top Flight Handicap (G1) winner Chain Bracelet.

Further back, D' Funnybone traces in tail-female line to his sixth dam, Courtesy, who proved herself a Foundation Mare within the legendary confines of Claiborne Farm. Courtesy's daughter and D' Funnybone's fifth dam, Continue, would go on to become the grandam of champions Forty Niner and Swale.

D' Funnybone is from the third crop of the Forest Wildcat stallion D'wildcat and represents his sire's first graded stakes winner.

A Grade 1-winning sprinter at age four, D'wildcat stands at Vinery Ltd. in Summerfield, Florida.

Like his late sire before him, D'Wildcat figures to do particularly well with Mr. Prospector-line mares.

A key ancestor in this regard would be Forest Wildcat's broodmare sire, Bold Native, a close relative of Mr. Prospector. Both were sired by Raise a Native, and both are descendants of the influential matriarch Myrtlewood.
