No turning back Decelerator in lively Debutante battle

After trading several bumps with her opponent during a spirited stretch duel, Westrock Stables' Decelerator bested Wild Forest Cat by a neck and then overcame an objection to notch her first stakes victory in the \$111,300 Debutante Stakes (G3) at Churchill Downs on June 27.

Sent off as the 1.30-to-1 favorite in a field of nine, the two-year-old Dehere filly covered six furlongs in 1:11.28 on track rated as fast.

For her Racing Hall of Fame trainer, D. Wayne Lukas, the victory marked a record seventh time he has saddled the winner of the Debutante.

Decelerator is undefeated in two lifetime starts. She won her debut by a half-length on a sloppy track at Churchill on May 14.

Her next scheduled start is the Schuylerville Stakes (G3) at

Saratoga Race Course on July 29.

Bred in Kentucky by Ted O'Neill, this dark bay or brown filly was a \$250,000 purchase at the Ocala Breeders Sales Co. February sale of selected two-year-olds in training.

Decelerator is the first foal out of the unplaced Accelerator mare Paris Rose, a half sister to 1997 Test Stakes (G1) winner Fabulously Fast.

A Grade 3 winner at two and Grade 1-placed at four, Accelerator initially stood in Central Kentucky at Hill 'n' Dale Farm before his sale and transfer to Turkey in 2002. He died from complications of laminitis in May 2003. Decelerator is the first graded stakes winner out of an Accelerator broodmare.

Decelerator's second dam, Fabulous Notion, won the Hollywood Starlet Stakes at two and the Santa Susana Stakes (G1) as a three-year-old.

Our subject's immediate family is anchored by his third dam, Careless Notion. She is the dam of Grade 1 winner Cacoethes. This also is the clan of 1998 champion turf female Fiji (GB) and multiple Grade 1 winner Subordination.

Decelerator hails from the 12th North American crop of veteran Coolmore shuttle stallion Dehere.

Sire of 28 graded or group stakes winners, Dehere stood the 2009 breeding season for \$15,000 at Ashford Stud in Versailles, Kentucky.

The most consequential pattern in Decelerator's pedigree is probably her 3x3 cross of Secretariat and Somethingfabulous, creating inbreeding to their common dam, the key matriarch Somethingroyal. This relatively infrequent tandem of half brothers has already appeared in the pedigree of 2004 champion two-year-old male Declan's Moon.

Decelerator receives two additional strains of this family from A.P. Indy's influential dam, Weekend Surprise, who carries a 1x3 cross of Secretariat and his half brother Sir Gaylord.
