

Discreetly Mine well stocked with ties to *La Troienne

In his first start around two turns, Discreetly Mine established an ideal pace and went on to lead at every point of call before scoring by $1\frac{1}{2}$ lengths in the \$300,000 Risen Star Stakes (G2) on February 20 at Fair Grounds.

The win was the first in a stakes for the three-year-old Mineshaft colt, who covered $1\frac{1}{6}$ miles in 1:44.88 on a track rated as fast.

As a two-year old, Discreetly Mine picked up his first victory in his third start before stepping up with a pair of strong runner-up finishes to D' Funnybone and Homeboykris at Belmont Park in the Futurity

(G2) and Champagne (G1) Stakes, respectively.

The bay E. Paul Robsham homebred has two wins and three seconds from seven starts and earnings of \$359,350. His next start is expected to come in the Louisiana Derby (G2) on March 27 at Fair Grounds.

Discreetly Mine was bred in Kentucky by Robsham, who also

bred his bountiful dam, 1995 Alabama Stakes (G1) winner Pretty Discreet. The Private Account mare previously produced 2006 Hill 'n' Dale Cigar Mile Handicap (G1) winner Discreet Cat, by Storm Cat, as well as Grade 1-placed multiple stakes winner Pretty Wild, by Wild Again. Their unraced half sister, Discreetly Awesome, is the dam of 2009 Matron Stakes (G2) winner Awesome Maria, by Maria's Mon.

Discreetly Mine's unplaced grandam, Pretty Persuasive, is a full sister to 1987 Kentucky Oaks (G1) heroine Buryyourbelief. Further back, Discreetly Mine's fifth dam, the *Mahmoud filly Happy Mood, finished in a dead heat for the win in the 1954 Acorn Stakes.

Discreetly Mine hails from the third crop of 2003 Horse of the Year Mineshaft, who stands at Lane's End in Versailles, Kentucky, for \$20,000.

Mineshaft's 13 stakes winners also include Grade 2 winners Casino

Discreetly Mine's "Derby-friendly" pedigree is reinforced by a rich network of strains from the great mid-20th century American matriarch *La Troienne, including three lines of her breed-shaping greatgrandson Buckpasser.

*La Troienne's great-granddaughter Glamour produced Poker, Seattle Slew's broodmare sire. Glamour also appears as the third dam of Private Account.

For good measure, Glamour's full sister, So Chic, is Mineshaft's fifth dam, creating an auspicious pattern of inbreeding to the family of the sire—and a rather influential clan at that.
