

## Sunland Derby winner bred on a proven cross

Undeterred by inexperience, WinStar Farms' Endorsement provided a bold and decisive case for his possible inclusion in this year's Kentucky Derby Presented by Yum! Brands (G1) as the three-year old Distorted Humor colt challenged and then drew clear of pacemaker and unbeaten favorite Conveyance en route to a three-length victory in the \$800,000 Sunland Derby (G3) on March 28.



Run at 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> miles, the rich Sunland Park event realized a significant rise in prominence this year after it was granted Grade 3 status and became the first graded Thoroughbred stakes race in New Mexico history. As a result, the lion's share (50%) of the purse assures Endorsement of a spot in the starting gate for the Kentucky Derby on May 1 should his connections choose to send him there.

## ENDORSEMENT

Endorsement entered off a powerful  $2\frac{1}{2}$ -length score in a  $1\frac{1}{6}$ -mile maiden special weight race at Oaklawn Park on February 20. His career mark now stands at two wins and one second from four starts and earnings of  $\frac{430,383}{23}$ .

Bred in Kentucky by Kilroy Thoroughbred Partnership, the chestnut colt was a \$450,000 purchase by Maverick Racing at the 2008 Keeneland September yearling sale.

During three seasons of racing, Endorsement's dam, the A.P. Indy mare Charmed Gift, won four times at distances ranging from one mile to  $1\frac{1}{6}$  miles. She was second in Grade 3 races twice at age three, both times to subsequent Grade 1 winner Take Charge Lady.

Charmed Gift also is the dam of 2009 Derby Mexicano winner Vistoso, by Fusaichi Pegasus. Among her most recent foals is a yearling full brother to Endorsement.

Our subject's second dam, Argentina's 1992 two-year-old champion filly Potridee (Arg), was imported to the U.S., where she captured the 1994 Vanity Invitational Handicap (G1) and later was third to Hatoof and Flawlessly in that year's running of the Beverly D. Stakes (G1).

This is a clan that continues to issue high-class runners on both

sides of the equator. Indeed, Potridee can claim a trio of Argentine Group 1-winning full sisters who have, in turn, produced graded or group stakes winners.

This is the immediate family of multiple Grade 2-winning long distance specialist T. H. Approval and Grade 3 winner Melhor Ainda, who finished second in the 2005 American Invitational Oaks (G1) and third that year in the Beverly D.

Endorsement hails from the eighth crop of the influential Forty Niner stallion Distorted Humor, who already has distinguished himself with Seattle Slew-line mares as the sire of 2003 dual classic winner and champion three-year-old male Funny Cide.

More recently, Distorted Humor's cross with daughters of A.P. Indy has yielded Grade 1 winner Any Given Saturday and Grade 3 winner Z Humor, Kentucky Derby starters in 2007 and '08, respectively.
