

## Top form follows impeccable breeding as Internallyflawless soars

To be sure, Charles Fipke's homebred Internallyflawless found a favorable occasion to record her first stakes victory as the regally bred Giant's Causeway filly was best by a half-length on August 22 in the \$350,000 Del Mar Oaks (G1).

Sent off as the 6.90-to-1 fourth betting choice in a field of ten, Internally flawless completed 1½ miles in 1:49.46 on firm turf. The three-year-old chestnut filly



entered off her first start of the season, a fourth-place finish in the San Clemente Handicap (G2) at the seaside track on August 1, when she lost by 11/4 lengths. The trio of fillies who bested Internallyflawless that day were part of the field left in her wake in the Del Mar Oaks.

**INTERNALLYFLAWLESS** 

Graded stakes-placed at two, her career mark improved to two wins from six starts and earnings of

\$267,400. Bred in Kentucky, Internallyflawless is the first starter from the Seeking the Gold mare Tapatina, who also is the dam of three younger foals by Perfect Soul (Ire).

Tapatina's celebrated relations begin with her three-quarter siblings: English classic winner and dual highweight Bosra Sham, by Woodman; French classic winner and juvenile highweight Hector Protector, by Woodman; and French classic winner Shanghai, by Procida.

Internallyflawless' second dam, Korveya, was a Group 3 winner in France at three.

Our subject's third dam, Konafa, was second to Flying Water in the 1976 One Thousand Guineas (Eng-G1). She also is ancestress of Grade 1 or Group 1 winners Ciro, Act One, and Passinetti as well as the Giant's Causeway colt Red Giant.

Internallyflawless' extended female family was developed by eminent Canadian horseman E. P. Taylor, who bought her fifth dam, \*Queen's Statute, as a yearling for \$10,185 at the 1955 Newmarket September sale.

Imported to Taylor's Windfields Farm in Ontario, \*Queen's Statute became a foundation mare for her owner, foaling six stakes winners.

Internally flawless hails from the sixth crop of the prominent Coolmore stallion Giant's Causeway, whose cross with the daughters of Seeking the Gold has shown to be particularly productive over the past 12 months.

Representatives also include last year's Juddmonte Spinster Stakes (G1) winner Carriage Trail; this year's Strub (G2) and San Pasqual (G2) Stakes winner Cowboy Cal; and Swift Temper, a three-time graded stakes winner in 2008 and '09.

Moreover, Giant's Causeway continues to perform at a premium with Mr. Prospector-line broodmares in general.

So far, such a collection of mares has combined to produce 308 foals, which is less than 27% of Giant's Causeway's 1,149 total foals of racing age. Yet this group accounts for 43% of his 69 stakes winners, 46% of his 39 graded or group stakes winners, and 69% of his 16 Grade 1 or Group 1 winners.

These are numbers that suggest an affinity at work.
