



PEDIGREE PROFILE

Does The Factor have the right blood to go the distance?

After shattering Santa Anita Park's six-furlong track record as a maiden and following up with a smart victory in the seven-furlong San Vicente Stakes (G2), the meteoric three-year old known as The Factor soared past another important checkpoint on the Triple Crown trail on March 19 at Oaklawn Park as he scored by 6¼ lengths in front-running fashion in the 1½-mile Rebel Stakes (G2), his first attempt around two turns.

And yet, more than a modicum of concern remains with this ultra-talented gray or roan colt as to whether he can overcome a pedigree that, relatively speaking, appears not so "Derby-friendly."

Breeders' Cup Handicap (G2) going six furlongs at Saratoga Race Course and was runner-up in five other graded sprints.

A key ancestor in the search for stamina might be War Front's multiple stakes-winning dam, Starry Dreamer, a rather atypical daughter of 1992 champion sprinter Rubiano who showed her best form in graded stakes company when going as long as 1½ miles on the turf. What might her influence be in a spot like this?

The Factor is the youngest of five winners from seven starters out of the Miswaki mare Greyciousness, the winner of two races at age three at distances of six furlongs and 1⅙ miles on the turf.

The Factor's grandam, Skatingonthinice, was a multiple stakes winner in the Midwest, scoring in eight of her 46 lifetime starts at distances between six furlongs and 1⅙ miles. The most talented of her offspring, Chief Seattle, was second in both the 1999 Breeders' Cup Juvenile (G1) and Champagne Stakes (G1).

Skatingonthinice's half sister, the speedster Showering, won the six-furlong Whimsical Stakes in 1995 at Woodbine.

The sires running along The Factor's female line are an indeterminate lot in terms of anticipating the transmission of stamina.

Miswaki was a European Group 1-winning sprinter who, when crossed with stout broodmares, has been known to sire offspring and grand offspring, for example Black Tie Affair (Ire) and Sea The Stars, who flourished at classic distances.

Sires of The Factor's second and fourth dams, Icecapade and *Rasper II, expressed female influences that more often than not have favored speed.

Dual classic winner Bold Forbes, sire of The Factor's third dam, had an overall influence that was rather limited.

All things considered, The Factor's pedigree is most likely that of a miler, and his dependence on the lead figures to render him vulnerable in most Kentucky Derby (G1) scenarios.
