

Smooth sailing for Test winner Turbulent Descent

Clearly one of the best of her generation, Turbulent Descent returned to her best distance of seven furlongs and scored her third Grade 1 victory with little challenge in the \$250,000 Test Stakes (G1) on August 6 at Saratoga Race Course.

The three-year-old Congrats filly has recorded six wins and two seconds from eight lifetime starts, a résumé that also features high-profile victories on the West Coast in the 2010 Hollywood Starlet Stakes (G1) and the Santa Anita Oaks (G1) earlier

this year.



Bred in Florida by Ocala Stud, Turbulent Descent was purchased last year for \$160,000 at the Ocala Breeders' Sales Co. April sale of two-year-olds in training. Her first three dams all were bred or co-bred by Three Chimneys Farm's Robert N. Clay.

She is one of three winners from four starters out of the unraced Forestry mare Roger's Sue.

Turbulent Descent's unplaced second dam, Fabulous, is a full sister to the dam of 2009 Ruffian Handicap (G1) winner Swift Temper, by Giant's Causeway. Fabulous also is a half sister to the dam of English highweight filly Music Show, by Noverre.

Turbulent Descent's immediate family is anchored by her third dam, the outstanding Slew o' Gold filly Gorgeous, whose major victories included the 1989 Ashland Stakes (G1) and Hollywood Oaks (G1) and 1990 Vanity Invitational Handicap (G1).

Gorgeous' three-quarter sister, 1990 Kentucky Oaks (G1) winner Seaside Attraction, produced champion two-year-old filly Golden Attraction.

Further back, Turbulent Descent's extended female family flourished under the charge of premier Canadian horseman E. P. Taylor. Her fourth and fifth dams, Kamar and Square Angel, both were Canadian champion three-year-old fillies who turned out to be highly influential broodmares.

Interestingly, Turbulent Descent is closely related to the winner of the 2009 Test, Flashing, a daughter of A.P. Indy out of a Mr. Prospector-line mare whose third dam was Kamar.

Turbulent Descent hails from the first crop of the A.P. Indy stallion Congrats. Her victory in the Hollywood Starlet would, in fact, be pivotal in her sire attaining last year's freshman sire title.

After serving his first four years at stud in Florida, Congrats was promoted to Vinery in Lexington for 2011.

Both of his top-level winners have been out of mares by sons of Storm Cat. His daughter, Wickedly Perfect, who captured last year's Darley Alcibiades Stakes (G1), is out of a daughter of Tabasco Cat.

Turbulent Descent's pedigree is a relatively inbred one. Her sire demonstrates the vaunted cross of Seattle Slew over Mr. Prospector, while her grandam carries a reversal of that cross.

Duplications of these two breed-shapers, members of the same extended family, are complemented by our subject's broodmare sire, Forestry, whose third dam, Bold Sequence, is a half sister to Gold Digger, the dam of Mr. Prospector.

Turbulent Descent's five-generation pedigree also exhibits inbreeding to fellow breed-shapers Northern Dancer, Buckpasser, and Secretariat. For good measure, the filly's family tree carries the full brothers, Graustark and His Majesty, 5x5.

One can only conclude that there is little evidence of turbulent descent.
